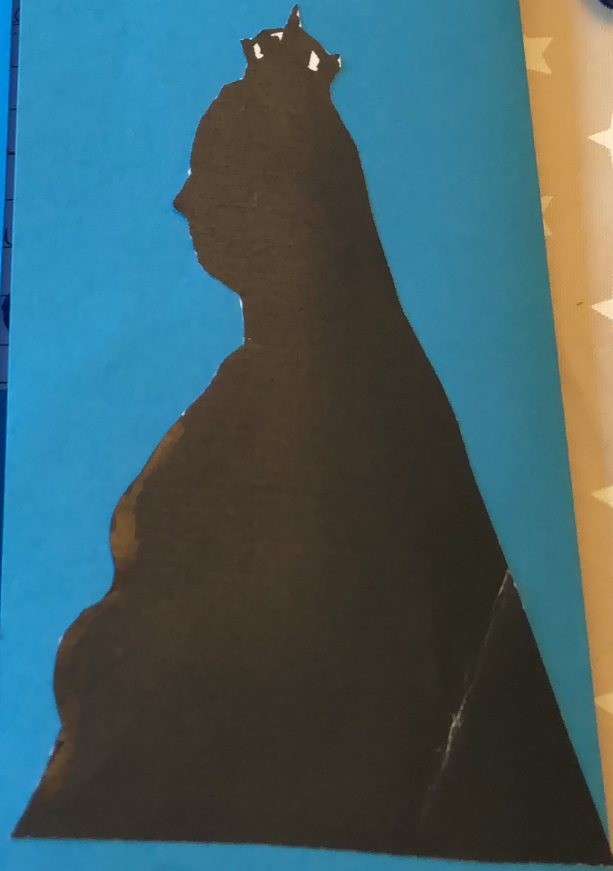
Fold the pages in to create a book shape like this.

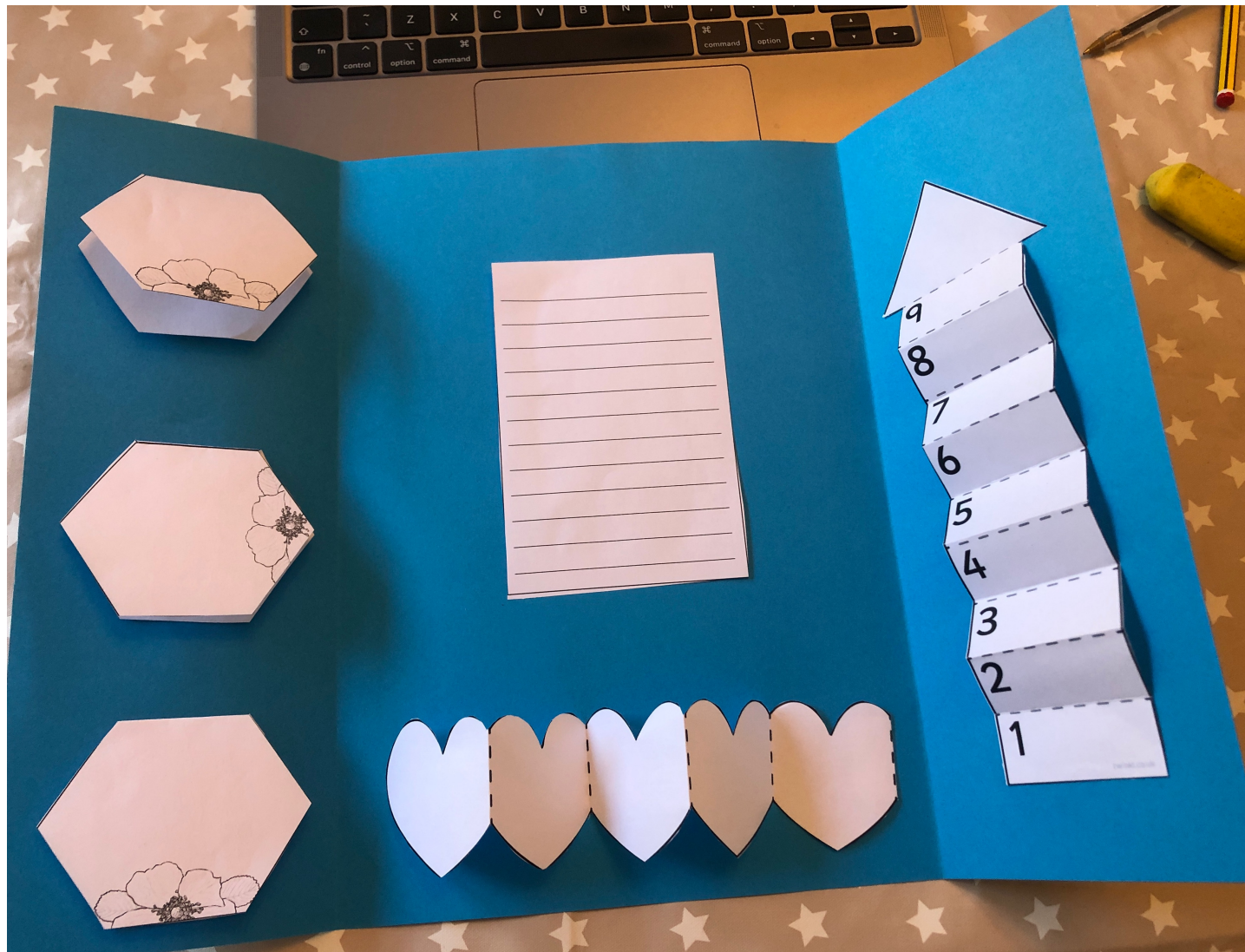

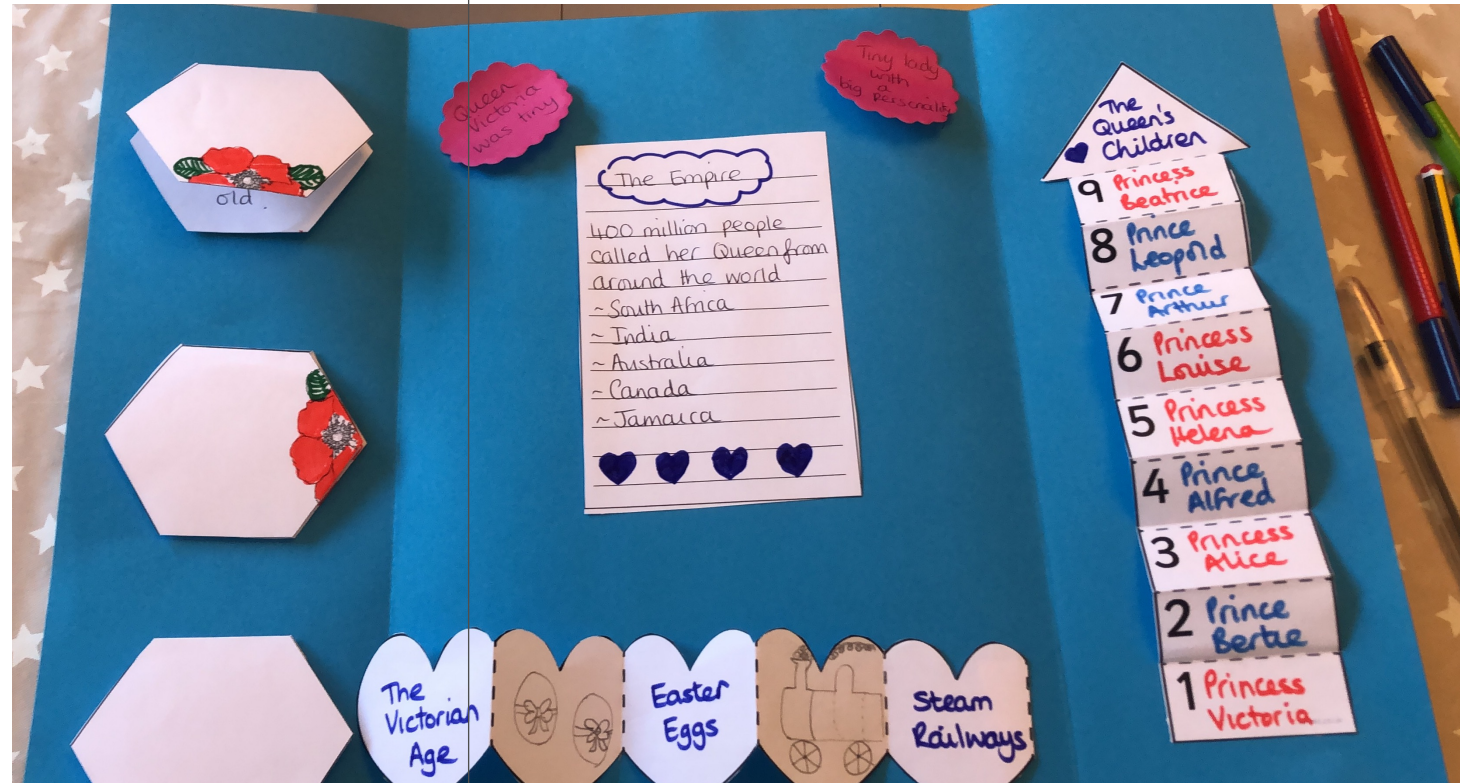
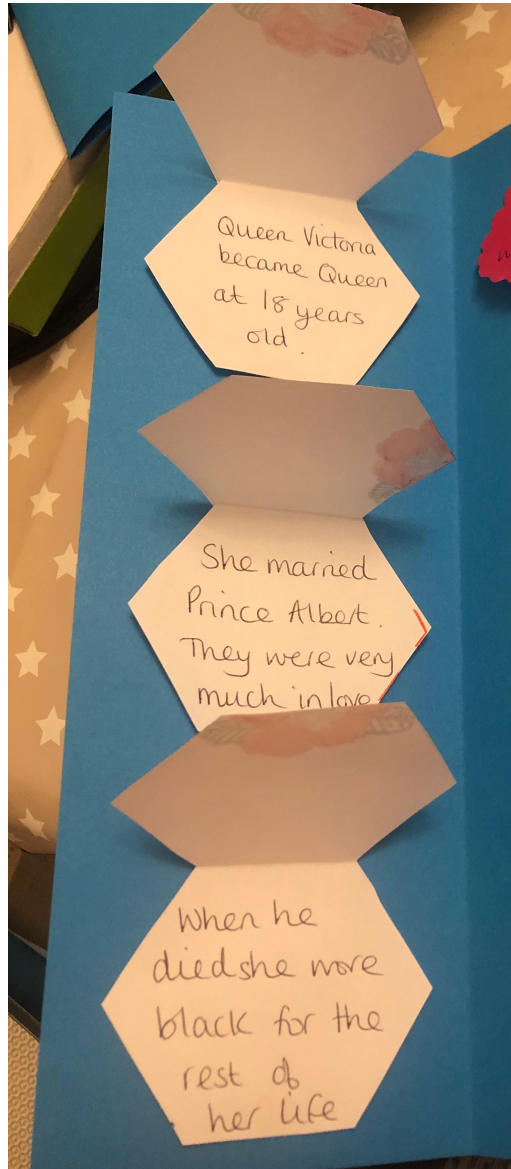
