Term 2		P4C Writing Spelling	- To continue to improve pupil voice, thinking skills, tolerance and respect - To improve writing so outcomes are in line with the other core subjects - To improve spelling skills across the school and embed with phonics provision and spelling support tools
Term 3		SEN RE	- To continue to develop rigorous systems for SEND provision and support learners effectively to make at least good progress - To embed the revised RE syllabus to enhance delivery of other faiths in RE and P4C sessions
Term 4		Behaviour Computing	- To review, finalise and monitor new policy and impact - To improve teachers subject knowledge and confidence to deliver a highly engaging computing curriculum
Term 5		Writing	To monitor and evaluate writing; making comparisons between core and foundation subjects so writing remains consistently high profile in all year groups
Term 6		Maths	To continue to promote purposeful, real life and practical problem solving experiences for the pupils
