Actions used to identify findings We were able to spend some time on Teams with Mrs Fargher (FF) who gave a detailed introduction and overview to RHSE. We received a Powerpoint presentation outlining the key points of the RHSE curriculum. Parents and pupils were consulted and Governors ratified the RHSE policy.	
What outcomes have been identified as a result of my visit Mrs Fargher has worked very hard to cross reference what is taught in other areas of the curriculum with the RSHE curriculum. Mrs Fargher shared the mind map that had been created showing that many areas of RHSE that were already covered within the broad curriculum that HT already provides (PHSE, ICT, Science, PE). Mrs Fargher has created a form for class teachers to fill in as they cover these areas, this will then enable her to easily monitor which areas have been covered and where there are gaps in the curriculum. Within the form, there are links to SCARF online workshops for each year group. These are resources which provide six week learning (half termly) plans that teachers can use or they can create their own plan. Part of her monitoring will be to support teachers in delivering the curriculum and to establish how confident they are to do this. Life Base workshops have been held in school with Yrs 1-6 which were well received. FF would like to introduce Big Books for RHSE. Pupils have these for other subjects and it's a great way to evidence and collate all the work.	
Impact of this visit We were pleased to hear that various aspects of the RHSE curriculum are already covered so that the impact on staff introducing a new curriculum will be minimised. The depth of work that has gone into considering how the RHSE curriculum will be delivered and monitored is very impressive.	

A lot of thought has gone in ensuring the workload of staff is not significantly increased by providing links to topic plans and a way to record when these have been covered.
