In Year Applications for Academic Year 2020-21

BM presented seven new in year applications for consideration.

The committee considered a letter from a Year 6 parent in support of their application, but felt unable to offer a space as the class is full and this would be unfair and inconsistent with previous decisions not to offer places to applicants when classes are full.
