Declaration of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

In Year Applications for Academic Year 2020-21

Ten new applications were considered by the Admissions Committee. Seven applications were refused as the classes are already either at the maximum infant class size (KS1) or at the maximum number agreed with the Local Authority (KS2).

The Committee agreed that three places should be offered for Year 5 applications as three spaces are available.

AOB

1. AB said that the induction video created for the new Reception Class due to start in September 2020 was excellent.
2. BM told the meeting that two of the new Reception intake children are currently living abroad but due to move back to houses owned by their parents by the end of August. SL has checked all the documentation and rules provided by RBWM and this is in line with their published admissions guidelines for Reception 2020/21. One of the families may not be able to move back before the end of August 2020, but RBWM have determined that this is as a result of exceptional circumstances created by the COVID-19 pandemic.
3. POB explained that the school has been approached to take part in discussions about Fair Access for a current Year 5 child, who has been without a school place for a number of weeks. There will be a meeting with a representative from the LA and other head teachers in a couple of weeks. Holy Trinity will not be proactively offering a place at the moment as nothing is yet known about where the child lives or what specific needs they have.
