Admissions Policy

We changed our Admissions over-subscription criteria (from 2019/20 onwards) to include Social and Medical. This required formal consultation. (Note formal consultation will not now be required for 7 years unless any further material changes made.)

Admissions Numbers

16th November 2017 - we increased admission number in bulge class from 50 to 54.

4th July 2018 - we are recommending an increase in admission number in bulge class from 54 to 60 ready for KS2.

Fair Access

No children admitted under Fair Access this year.

We will have had 2 appeals this year. Note imminent appeal for a place in Class 5 in September.
