Christmas Eve comes early for Year 3!

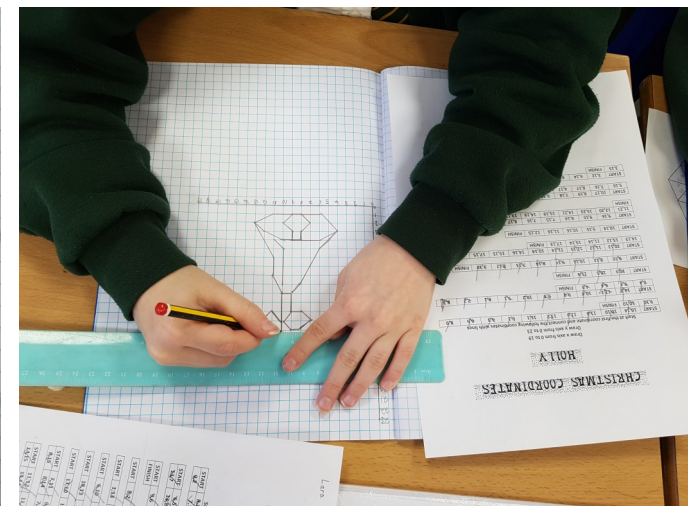
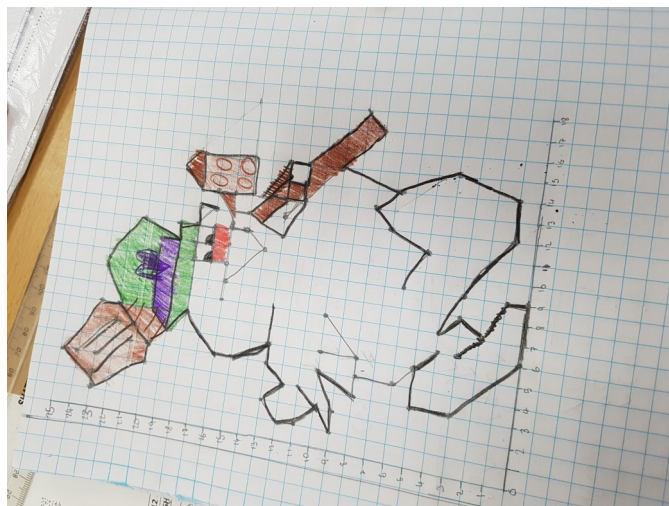
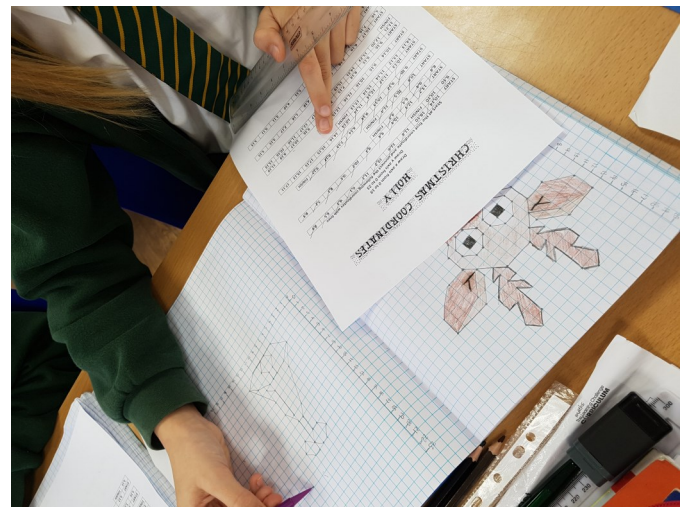
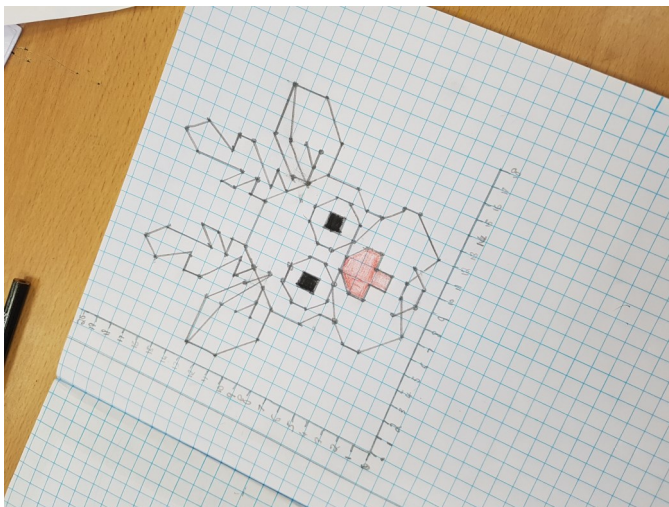
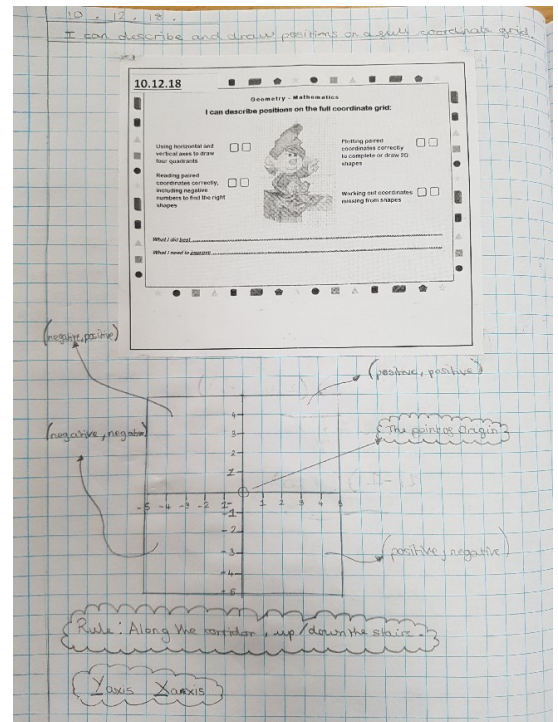
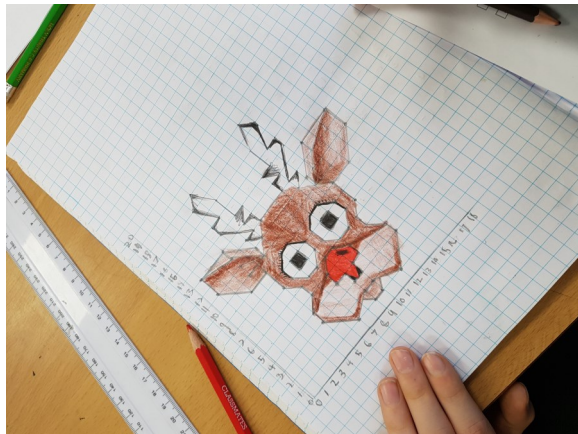

Year 6 Get Festive in Maths

Year 6 have started getting into the festive spirit in Maths through our work on coordinates. We are moving on from only using 1 quadrant where the coordinates are all positive numbers to using all 4 quadrants which involve negative numbers also. Check out an example page from our books to find out the rules for coordinates and which quadrants use the following: (positive, positive), (positive, negative), (negative, positive) and (negative, negative).

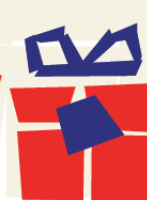
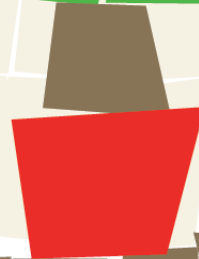
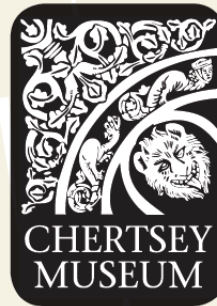
