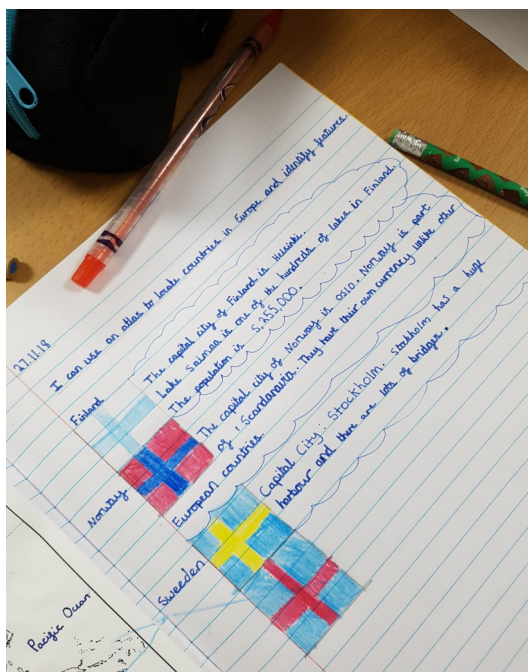
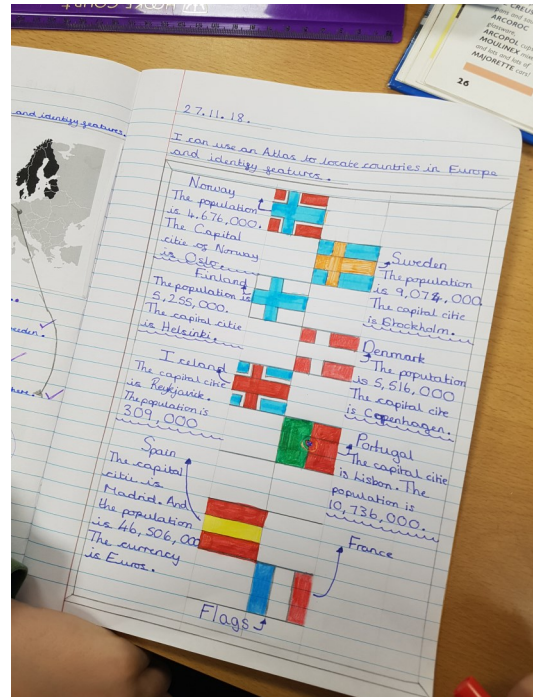
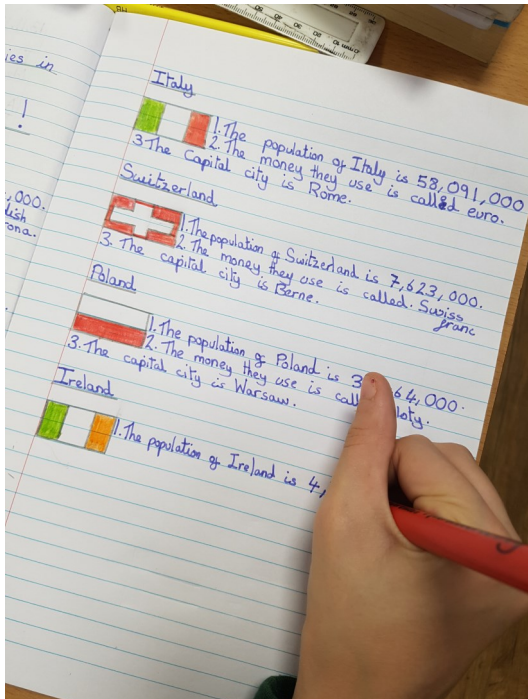
Year 6 have been working hard on their Geography as you can see! Can you talk to the children at the dinner table about where in the world we are? Here are some challenges for them to go away and work on!

KS1—Year 6 challenge you to locate 5 European countries.

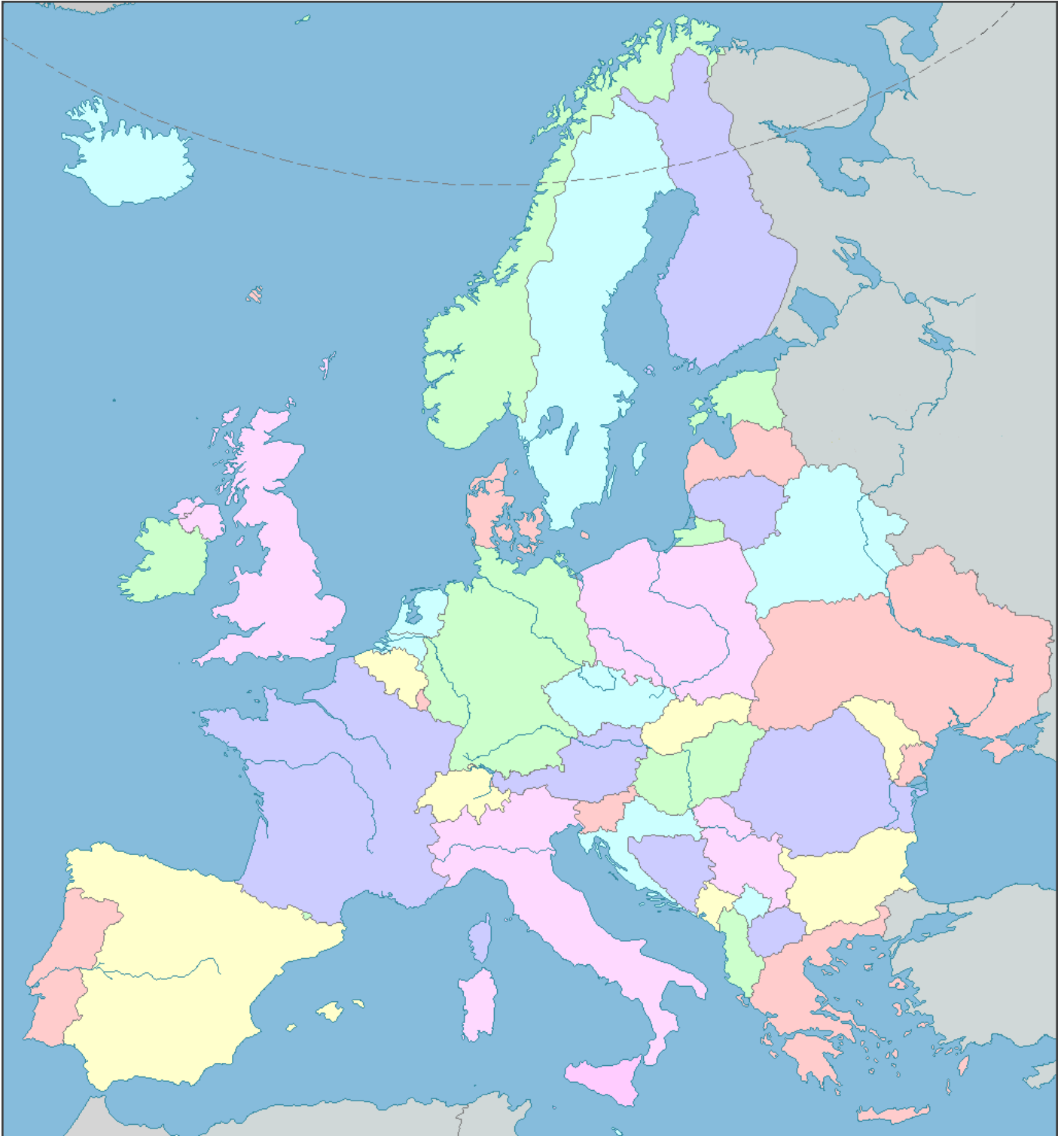
KS2—Year 6 challenge you to locate 10 European countries and name their capital cities.

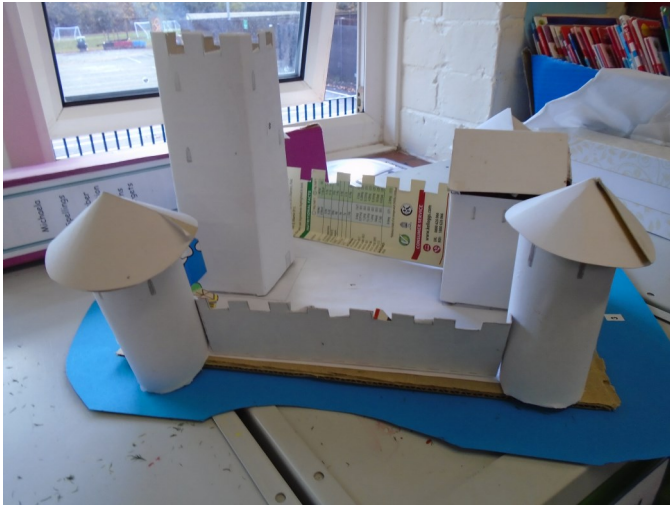

Are you claiming any benefits? Then Extra Funding Might be Available!

Your child may qualify for additional support with their education, as well as free school meals, if you are claiming certain benefits. The extra funding is still payable to school if your child is in Reception Class and KS1 and already receiving free school meals or prefers to have a packed lunch.

If you claim any of the benefits listed below it's worth checking—which is free, quick and easy. Pick up a form from School Reception, fill it in and hand in to the School Office for processing.

Universal Credit

Income Support

Income based Jobseeker Allowance

Employment & Support Allowance

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit

Child Tax Credit provided you're NOT also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of less than £16,190

Working Tax Credit run on—paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying

Pupil Premium funding may also be available if your child ceased to be looked after through:

- Adoption
- A Special Guardianship Order
- A Residence Order
- A Child Arrangements Order

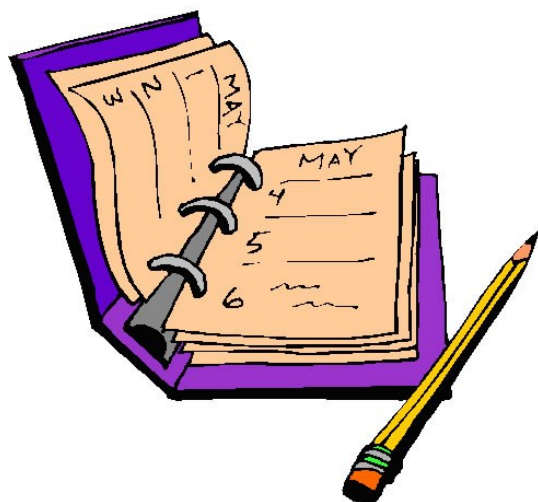

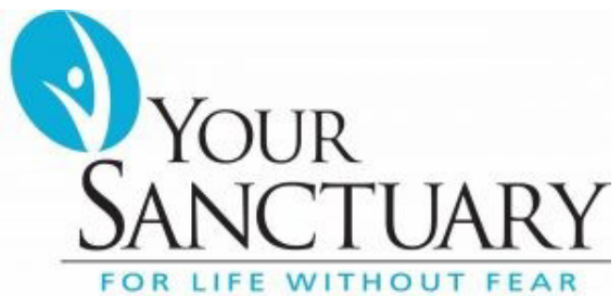
