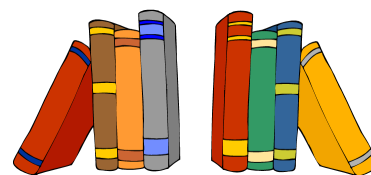
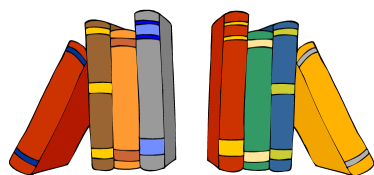
Paying For School Lunches

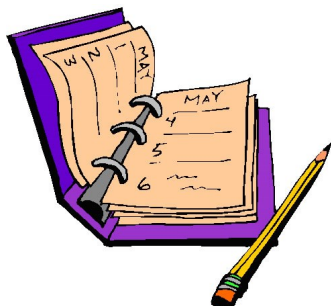
