School Council Applications

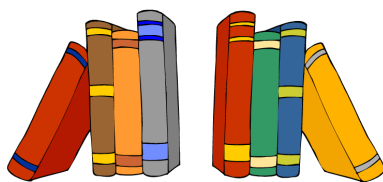

Sunningdale Party in the Park, at Holy Trinity Primary School

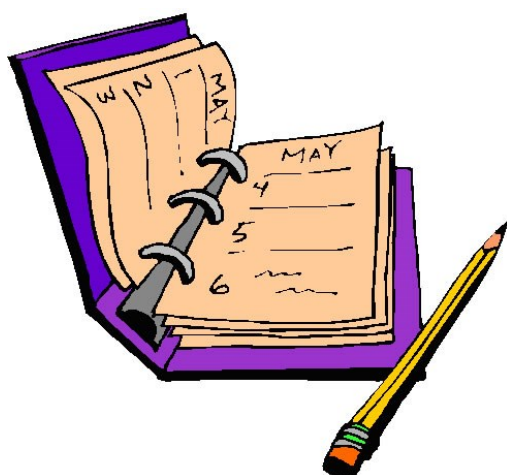
Sunday 16th September, 12pm -4pm
