We will update you as soon as possible on the funds raised for our Summer events.

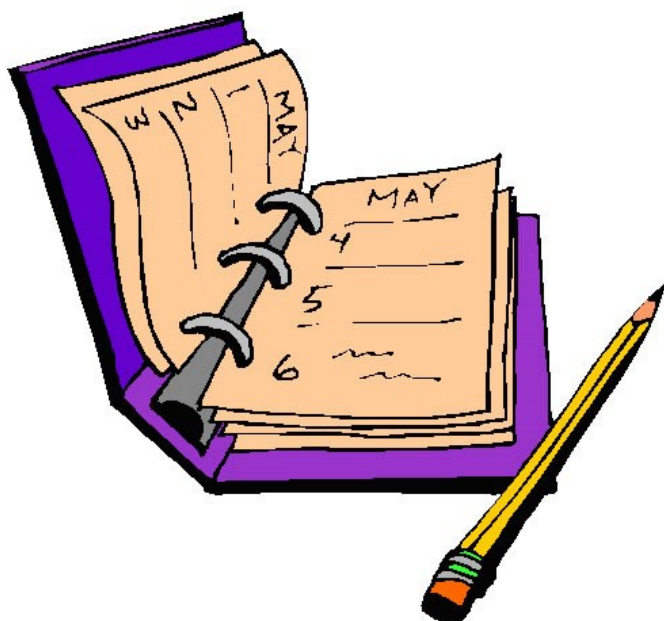

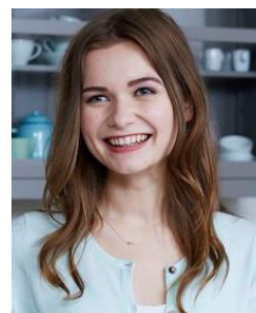
