The ONLY way to know for sure that your children don't have headlice is to coat the hair with conditioner and comb thoroughly with a nit comb, rinsing the comb regularly in a bowl of water as you go. You might be surprised at what you find!

Congratulation to John—Year 5

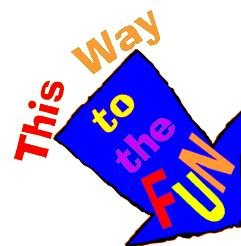

Here are some reminders in the run up to the school fair:

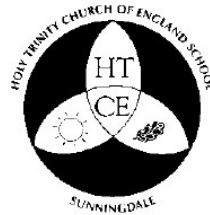
- Don't forget to return your bought and any unused raffle tickets to the school office or PTA postbox by Friday morning

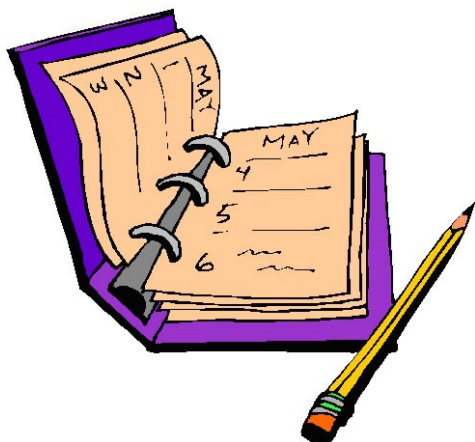
- 9.30am: Sports Day – Families welcome

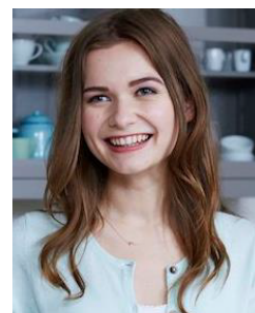
