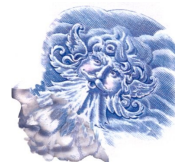

Reception and Year 1 Visit to the London Wetlands Centre

Reception and year 1 had a superb day out at London Wetlands Centre last Tuesday. The weather was warm and dry and the children loved exploring the wetlands and seeing what different animals are found in our ponds and wetland areas.

Reception had a chance to go pond dipping. They found pond and ramhorn snails. They also found a hoglouse, freshwater shrimps and a bloodworm. We sang a song, 'Old Macdonald had a pond....' About everything we found in the pond! We went to a bird hide and were so quiet, so that we didn't disturb the birds and other visitors. We visited the otter area, and saw lots of ducks, geese and swans. We ended the day with a session in their exciting playzone.

First we went on the coach and it took over one hour. Then we did a tour around the Wetland Centre. Next we went to the adventure playground and when I was at the park I played in the mole tunnel. After that we left the

In our pond dipping experience, Year 1 children found stickleback fish, ram horned snails and caddis lava fly. We looked at the creatures through a visualiser and spotted really clearly the camouflage of sticks on the caddis lava fly. It was a great adventure and we learned lots about what lives below the pond.

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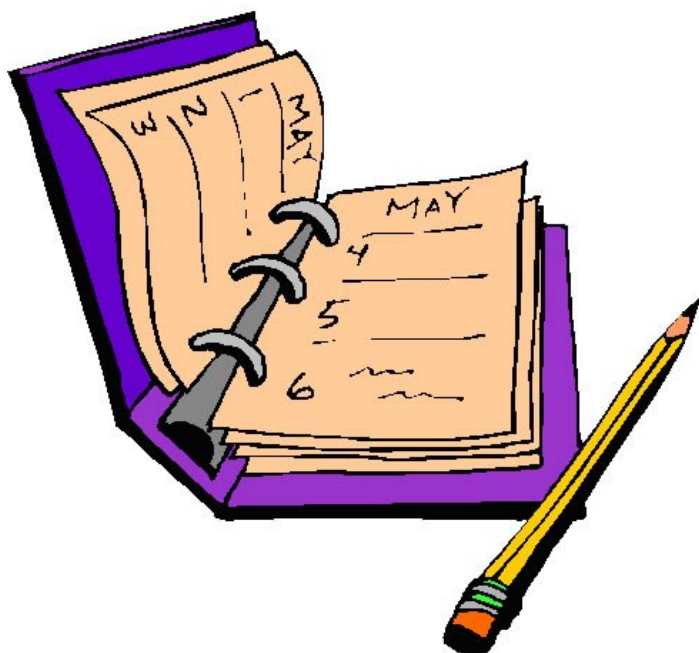

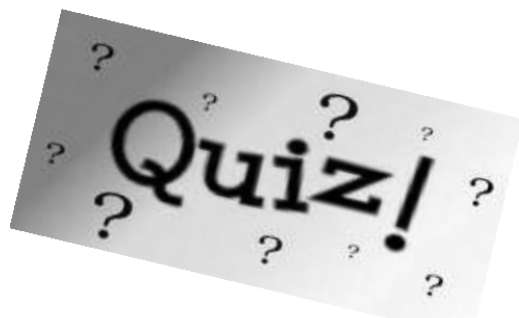
