Year 6 Trip to Harry Potter World

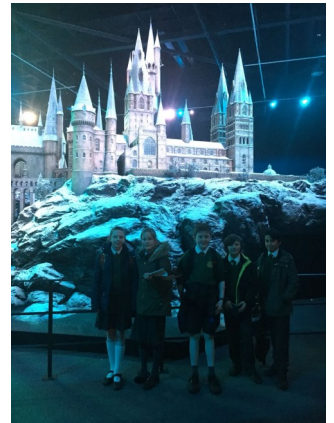

We will happily receive your book donations after half term.

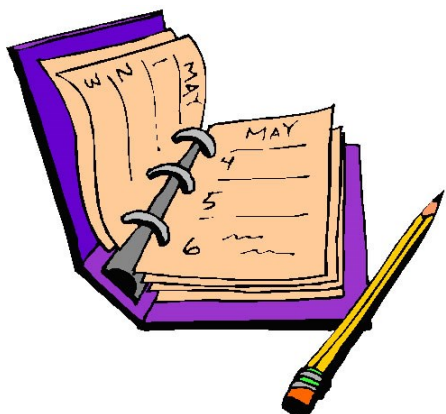

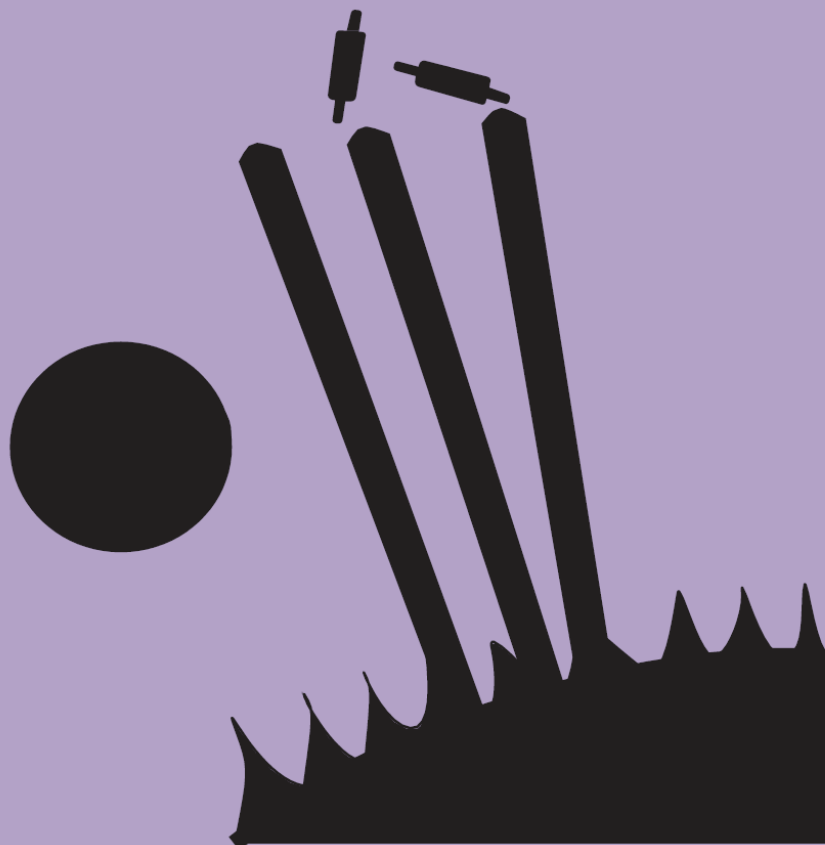
