Are you registered for GreenRedeem?

We have been accepted as one of the schools in the RBWM Donation Scheme from January 5th next year. 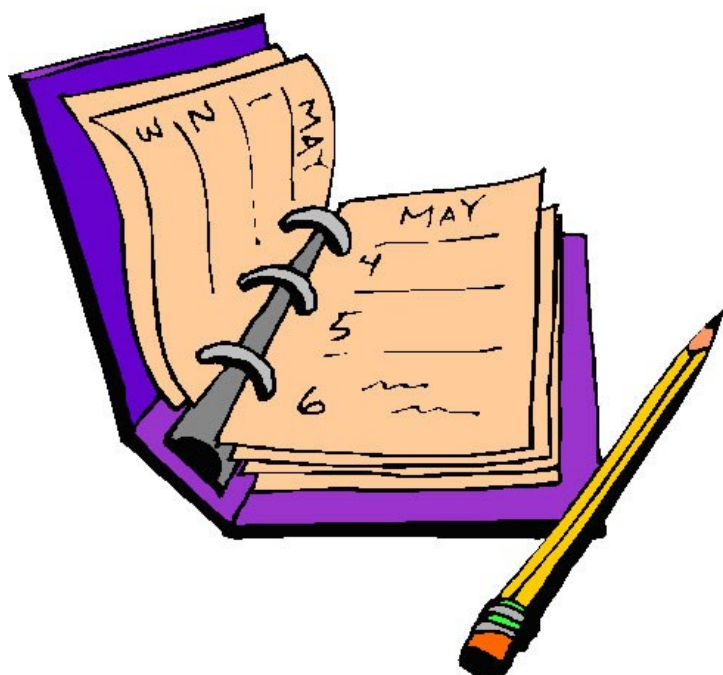
