Home and School Procedures and Behaviours **during Covid-19 Re-Opening**

Staff will:

- Remind children to thoroughly wash hands for at least 20 seconds regularly and when entering and exiting room/areas on the school site
- Protect self and children by keeping a 2m distance where possible
- Remind children of the social distancing guidance of 2m – child friendly posters will be displayed to remind children and show safe distancing pictorially
- Teach hygiene (coughing and sneezing into inside elbow) and safe disposal of used tissues
- Clean surfaces, resources frequently touched areas (light switches etc) regularly throughout the day

Parents will:

- Share the expectations of children set out in the section below with their children before they return to school
- Educate children in thorough and regular handwashing
- Ensure their child attends school in clean clothes (guidance is to wash daily)
- Arrive at school at the allotted time and at the designated entrance. For late arrival, please join the end of the queue, abiding by accepted social distancing practice and observing 2m gap at all times
- Collect from school at the allotted time and from the designated entrance. Parents to observe accepted social distancing practice whilst on site to maintain safety of the Holy Trinity community and all staff
- NOT enter the school site at any time unless expressly invited to do so
- We respectfully request that families follow official government guidance for **all** social interactions, in order to protect our staff and all the children within our setting.
- Monitor, their child's temperature daily. Children who show signs of fever (temperature above 38°C) or other Covid-19 symptoms as listed on the NHS 111 site should not attend school and be kept at home for the wellbeing of the Holy Trinity community and All staff.
- Ensure the whole family adheres to guidance for self-isolation if any family member exhibits symptoms of Covid-19, (14 days isolation)

Children will:

- Wash/sanitise their hands upon entry into school
- Enter school with a snack and water bottle only and put it into their zipped wallet.
- Make sure they put rubbish firmly in the bin
- Stay seated at their desk unless invited by an adult to move around (Y1 to Y6)
- Try their utmost to stay at least 2m away from their classmates and adults
- Try their utmost NOT to touch anyone else or anyone else's belongings
