Each faith tradition has teachings about the importance of treating others as we ourselves would wish to be treated. These teachings inspire and underpin engagement of people of different faiths with others and their social action for the wellbeing of society. These teachings are sometimes called the Golden Rule. There are equivalents in non-religious belief writings. The Inter Faith Network for the UK has worked with its member bodies since 1987 for inter-faith understanding and cooperation in the UK. The Golden Rule quotations here were drawn together by it, with the assistance of its Faith Communities Forum.
