It is not about making pupils 'religious' but creating opportunities for the pupils to reflect on the big issues.  MIRRORS: giving children opportunities to <i>reflect</i> on their experiences; to meditate on life's big questions and to consider some possible answers. In this they are learning <i>from</i> life by exploring their own insights and perspectives and those of others.
