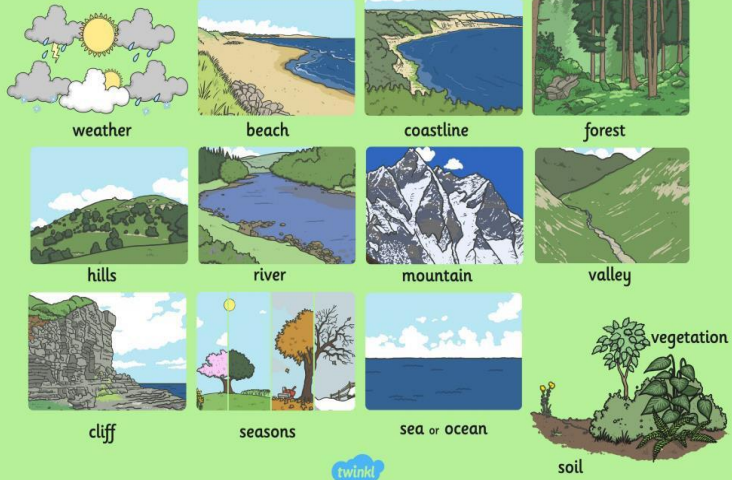

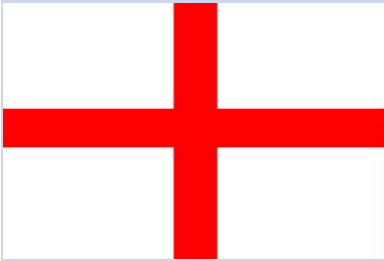


Key Vocab

1	Beach	an area of sand sloping down to the water of a sea or lake
2	Coastline	a line that forms the edge between the land and the ocean or a lake
3	Forest	A large area filled with many trees
4	Mountain	A mountain is a landform that rises high above its surroundings. It is taller than a hill.
5	Valley	a long depression, or ditch, in Earth's surface
6	City	A large town. Manchester and London are cities
7	Town	A thickly settled area that is usually larger than a village but smaller than a city
8	Village	a place where people live that is usually smaller than a town
9	Harbour	a deep body of water that protects boats near land
