



Prior Learning:

Pupils will already know

- ◇ The Big Story of the Bible
- ◇ The Gospels tell the story of Jesus life and death.
- ◇ Christians believe the life, death and resurrection of Jesus was planned by God to restore the relationship between humans and God.
- ◇ Christians see Jesus as their Saviour.

Key Skills Taught

Investigate: ask relevant questions; know how to use different types of sources as a way of gathering information.

Empathise: consider the thoughts, feelings, attitudes, beliefs and values of others; identify feelings such as love, wonder, forgiveness and sorrow ; see the world through others eyes.

Express: explain concepts and practices, interpret symbols and respond through a range of media.

VOCABULARY

Salvation: Being saved from sin.

Crucifixion: A form of execution where a person is bound or nailed to a cross.

Resurrection: The rising of Christ from the dead.

Ascension: Action of rising to an important position or a higher level.

Incarnation: God the Son in human flesh as Jesus Christ.

Freedom: The power or right to act, speak or think as you want.

Sacrifice: An act of giving up something valued.

Epitaph: means on the tomb

Secular: not regarded as religious.

Luke: A gospel account of Jesus' life.

Key Knowledge Taught: *by the end of the unit, pupils are expected to know that:*

- Explain connections between the Christian concepts of Sacrifice, Resurrection, Salvation, Incarnation and Hope using the Gospel of Luke (Chapter 24)
- Belief in the Resurrection confirms to Christians that Jesus is the Son of God and death is not the end.
- Make connections how Christians worship on Good Friday and Easter Sunday
- This belief gives Christians hope for life with God.
