Key Skills Taught

Investigate: ask relevant questions; know how to use different types of sources as a way of gathering information.

Empathise: consider the thoughts, feelings, attitudes, beliefs and values of others; identify feelings such as love, wonder, forgiveness and sorrow ; see the world through others eyes.

Express: explain concepts and practices, interpret symbols and respond through a range of media.

VOCABULARY

Creation: The action or process of bringing something into existence.

Sin: A bad choice, something that is wrong.

Design: A plan to show how something looks, works and functions.

Genesis: First book in the bible

Awe and Wonder: Something that makes you say wow

Image: A picture or likeness

Temptation: The desire to do something wrong

Forgiveness: Saying sorry

Key Knowledge Taught: *by the end of the unit, pupils are expected to know/be able to:*

- God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.
- As human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God.
- The bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him – he keeps his relationship with them, give them guidelines on good ways to live (Ten Commandments)
- God made our wonderful world, and we need to look after it (Stewardship). Make links between Genesis and what Christians believe about God.
