

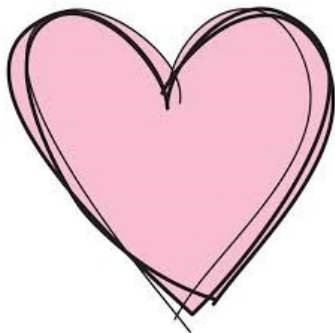

Greed: Wanting more

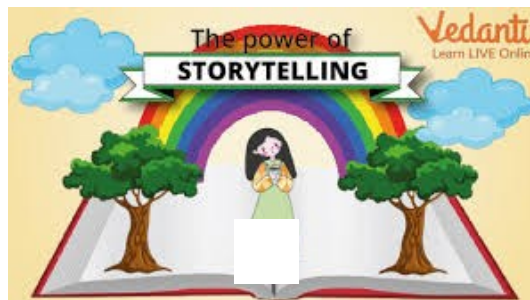
