Key Skills Taught

Investigate: ask relevant questions; know how to use different types of sources as a way of gathering information.

Bible: Christian special book that tells us about Jesus and God.

Parable: a simple story told by Jesus

Christian: Someone who has a relationship with Jesus and believes in God

Worship: To show a lot of love.

God: Is the name of a special person that Christians believe made the world. God, the Father.

Forgiving: Stop being angry with someone who has done something wrong.

Father: Creator of the World

Lord/King: Having power
